Thank you for your continued patience & cooperation during these changing times.

The Committee are continuing to monitor and review the restrictions we have in place, and in line with Government guidelines we feel we can now relax these further. Please see below for the current status which will apply from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July.

**Please remember that the following relaxation to restrictions is dependent on you continuing to observe all Government guidelines and social distancing rules. "Test & Trace" is now in operation so anybody who comes within 2 metres of a person testing positive for Covid-19 is likely to be asked to self-isolate at home for 14 days. If this applies to you then you will not be able to go fishing for 14 days.**

**Relaxation of restrictions with effect from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July**

- **Firgrove** – No restrictions in place
  - Fishing times remain as 08:30 to dusk
  - **When leaving Firgrove in the evening, Members should check to see if anyone else is still fishing. If no one else is still there, then please lock the gate on the way out**
- **Wyndhams & Rivers** – No restrictions in place
- **Church Farm Night Fishing**
  - Restrictions on night fishing have now been removed
  - Anglers are permitted to fish more than 24 hours consecutively without having to be off the venue
  - Please ensure you check your permits and comply with the clubs night fishing rules, where booking on is still compulsory
  - Members only are permitted on site
- **Church Farm Day Fishing** – No restrictions in place
  - Access & fishing times as printed in permit
- **Church Farm Toilet** – This will reopen
  - Please ensure you leave the toilet as you wish to find it
  - Sanitise your hands before and after entry of the toilet
  - Abuse of the toilet will see it closed and possible fishing restrictions brought back in
- **Lakeside Park** – No restrictions in place
  - Access & fishing times as printed in permit
- **Day Tickets** – These are now available again from Yateley Angling Centre
  - With the exception of Church Farm
  - Fishing at Church Farm remains for members only, on all lakes, at this time
- **Hand Sanitiser & Social Distancing**
  - It is requested that all members carry hand sanitiser. Please use it before and after operating gate locks
  - Please continue to apply social distancing of 2 metres wherever possible

**Our venues will continue to be monitored and restrictions will be reviewed with reference to any change in Government policy, guidelines or advice**
